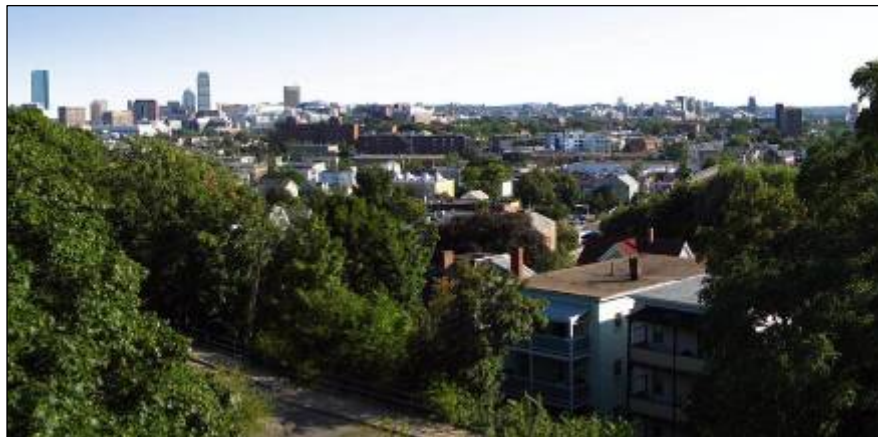

## Union Square Open Space Plan

Mayor Joseph Curtatone and the Office of Strategic Planning and Community Development (OSPCD) invite you to a public meeting about the proposed Union Square Open Space Plan. The Plan represents an opportunity to focus on a distinct area of Somerville that is anticipating future change as a result of the Green Line Extension. It is meant to help guide this transition to ensure that accessible open space, whether on public or private property, is designed to meet community needs and goals.

The Union Square-specific plan is part of the City's draft 2008-2013 Open Space and Recreation Plan, which will be submitted to the Massachusetts Division of Conservation Services in spring 2009.
